The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "Avoid the seven destructive sin." It was asked: (by those present): "What are they, O Messenger of Allah?" He replied, "Associating anyone or anything with Allah in worship; practising sorcery, killing of someone without a just cause whom Allah has forbidden, eating of usury, devouring the property of an orphan, fleeing from the battlefield and slandering chaste women who never even think of anything touching chastity and are good believers. [Al-Bukhari and Muslim].
